### **Sexual Misconduct Policy and Procedures allegations:**

- A. **Sexual Harassment** means conduct on the basis of sex that satisfies one or more of the following:
- (1) **Sexual Assault:** An offense classified as a sex offense under the uniform crime reporting system of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Sex Offenses are any sexual act including Rape, Sodomy, Sexual Assault With An Object, or Fondling directed against another person, without the Consent of the victim, including instances where the victim is incapable of giving Consent; also, unlawful sexual intercourse (Incest or Statutory Rape).
    - (a) **Rape:** Penetration, no matter how slight, of the vagina or anus with any body part or object, or oral penetration by a sex organ of another person, without the Consent of the victim, including instances where the victim is incapable of giving Consent because of their age or because of their temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity.
    - (d) **Fondling:** The touching of the private body parts of another person for the purpose of sexual gratification without the Consent of the victim, including instances where the victim is incapable of giving Consent because of their age or because of their temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity.

It is alleged that the following incident(s) occurred:

Alex had been hanging out in Terry's room with other friends in Dedmond Hall on Friday, December 12. Alex consumed a lot of alcoholic beverages and was really "out of it." As other people began to leave the room, Terry asked Alex to stay as they talked about the status of current relationship situation. Alex vaguely remembers that Terry was kissing her and that she tried to push her away. Then she remembers that Terry sexually assaulted her. She does not remember how she returned to her residence hall room.
